Note for assembly

Before opening the bag, please carefully read this instruction manual and verify that all the parts are included. Please also refer to the 1/48" Shinden "instruction manual to use these parts.

To build this kit, please prepare big pliers, cutters, files, sandpapers, instant glue pin vise and drill blades (0.5mm diameter) metal primer spray.


In order to assemble this kit, once you have worked and embedded the 1/48" Shinden "machine gun parts (A-9, A-10, A-11, A-12) you need to assemble them to the main fuselage of the kit. Please check your work regularly.

Please note that these parts cannot be glued with plastic model kit cement. Instant glue should be used instead.

Before painting, clean up the basic surface with a metal primer spray, (If you don 't, the paint may peel off as time passes by.)

The recommended brand for painting your kit is the latest line of paint from Vallejo Color. While referring to Zoukei-Mura 1/48" Shinden "Instruction Manual and historical resources on the Japanese Imperial Navy, you may paint the model with the coloring of your choice.

Use all the tools and solutions for assembling and painting by following their respective instruction manuals.
